Co-Sponsoring with OCC

This past Saturday, March 31, BPWSOC co-sponsored with Ocean County College on their Women's Career and Life Event, "Becoming Fearless in Career and Life."

Brief speeches were given by Dr. Jon Larson, President, OCC, Mr. Don Doran, VP of Student Affairs, OCC, Dr. Kate Pandolpho, Director Career, Employment and Counseling Service, OCC.

Afterwards Ms. Bernadette Amato, Coordinator of Career Services, OCC and Ms. Virginia Watts, Project Coordinator in the Construction Industry spoke about becoming fearless in non-traditional employment. Both women, especially Ms. Watts, told how to overcome the fear of breaking into non-traditional jobs, i.e., construction.

But the best part of the morning was hearing Ms. Donna Cardillo, RN, MA speak about becoming fearless in life and career. Ms. Cardillo was informative, humorous, motivational and a real role-model for women everywhere.

She spoke about knowing yourself, your strengths and weakness and what it is your really love to do; that is what you need to focus on and master. She gave examples of

events in her life that could have stopped her dead in her tracks, but she considered the source, and overcame any fear or hesitation she might have had and forged ahead to see her dream a reality. She spoke about the strategies for positive thinking and self-motivation and how important it is to follow these strategies and let nothing hold you back. But most importantly she said women should avoid generalizations and misconceptions, such as "everyone wants experience," "everyone wants a degree," you can't get into that industry," there are no jobs available," or "you've got to be certified to do that."

Ms. Cardillo stated that "generalizations are dangerous and never true of a situation. If you lock into any of them, it will prevent you from moving forward. They're just another excuse for inactivity. Misconceptions are based on fear and misinformation. Most obstacles are in our own mind."

How true!

PC Tips by Lisa G., A2Z Computer Help

Maintaining your printer:

It is very easy to forget about your peripheral (a peripheral is any device connected to your pc, that provides a service ie...printer, mouse, web cam, flash drive etc...) devices. All devices need to be maintained.

One very important one to us, is our printer. Here are some maintenance tips:

- Keep it clean
- dust free
- blow out with canned air
- check your print cartridges (your printer software has a service or tools area where you can go in and click on different printer head cleaning and alignment options)
- be sure not to touch the contacts on the print cartridges
- you may use a moistened (with just a little water) Qtip to clean areas inside the printer.
- Turn off your printer, even if you do not shutdown your pc. You may even cover your printer if you want, when it is off.
- Use your printer. Some of us do not use it that often.
 This alone can render it nonfunctional. The print
 cartridges tend to dry up, therefore, you should try to
 print something each day or a couple times a week.

At some point, they may just stop functioning properly and you may need to uninstall it and it's software and reinstall it. And sometimes, it just may not work properly anymore. I usually feel if it's been a good 5 years or more, I can live with purchasing a new one, if less - most times it is fixable.

Everything needs to be maintained in some shape or form. If you need help with maintenance, do not hesitate to contact me.
