Another one is the Social Security Administration: "The Social Security Administration will never threaten, scare, or pressure you to take an immediate action." "Do not give scammers money or personal information – Ignore Them!" And, most importantly, report them: You can <u>click here</u> to go to the Office of the Inspector General to report scams that pertain to various Social Security fraud, scams, waste, and abuse. All legitimate companies have a way for you to report the scams to them. Just visit their websites and or give them a call (use your actual bill/statement or online account to contact them). These are just a few mentioned. Remember, have fun, but stay alert! We all want to buy gifts for each other or ourselves, but we must be careful.
