

This is part of the initial setup and I find that so many people do not have their Recovery Media created. Usually the manufacturer will recommend that this be the first thing you do. It is sometimes in the instructions enclosed or there is a reminder that pops up once your pc is setup. FYI - Apple requires this also! Finally, the great importance of this task is so that if your hard drive were to crash or become corrupt or a virus takes over; to do a reinstall of the Operating System will require the Recovery Media. Note, several years back, this didn't concern the consumer because the media (discs) came with your new computer along with the User's Guide or Manual. Now, we are all responsible to download, create, print etc...the required media and/or documentation.
