Visit us at www.bpwsoc.org (smartphones, tablets, etc...) all work and or function just like a computer, so you do not have to use your computer.

This is all fine and wonderful, but remember we are not completely there yet. Everything is happening and changing each day. So, I am suggesting that you become as savvy as possible (meaning, if something does not work one way, realize that there is probably another way for it to work and or even another. I always say there are 10 ways to do everything on your computer).

This subject came about when one of my clients commented on the "Mobile" view of their website. What is "Mobile" view? This is when we use our smartphone or tablet to view a website, for example, <u>www.bpwsoc.org</u>. You type in the URL/domain name or address (you see, right there, there are 3 ways to refer to <u>www.bpwsoc.org</u>), and then you click search and the website comes up. On some phones it shows in mobile view and on some it shows in web view. Either way, some websites will have an option if you scroll down at the bottom of the page to toggle between mobile and web. If you do toggle between both, you will see that the website views a bit differently each way. You may see more or less in either view.

As with browsers on our computers, we can toggle between them when we visit any website. Sometimes you will notice that something is not visible or showing on a particular website, but you will find that if you use a different browser it will view as it should. This is all due to the

different code that is used for the kabillions of websites, browsers, and different platforms used out there. Everyone is trying to catch up to the next best thing and then something new comes along.

Not to digress too much, but this also leads to why it is very important to keep your computer as well as your smartphones and tablets up to date. The updates are what helps us along with all the new stuff that is constantly being created.

So, the moral of this "tip" is, think outside the box (be creative), and stay up to date!


