BPWSOC - Holiday Fundraiser

The Executive Committee has chosen Ocean's Harbor House for it's Christmas Fundraiser organization. Harbor House was founded in 1985 to create a place that runaway, homeless and abused youth could go where they would be safe, free from abuse and victimization. A place that would also work with caring parents and family members to mediate crisis and rediscover the bonds of affection that are the cornerstone of any loving, capable family. On August 8, 1988 the Harbor House Youth Shelter opened its doors.

The cornerstone of the agency is their Emergency Youth Shelter designed to meet the immediate needs of youth ages, 10-19. Services provided include:

- Temporary Housing
- Individual, Group, & Family Counseling
- Crisis Intervention Services
- Food & Clothing
- Medical Attention
- Parent & Teen Mediation
- Case Management
- Advocacy & Referral Services
- Drug & Alcohol Counseling

All services are free, voluntary, and confidential. Services are available to ALL youth and families in the community. All staff are qualified counselors trained in crisis intervention.

Penny has contacted Harbor House and was sent the [attached](#) list of "Wish List" items that the kids asked for. You will note from this list that it includes items that we and our children take for granted. But for these kids, these items are luxuries. At the BPWSOC November and December meetings, we will accept any items on

the list. Stalo has agreed to store them for us. Also at the December meeting, a representative from Harbor House will be invited to attend so that they can take possession of what has been collected and bring it back to the kids.

We ask all members to purchase items from this list and bring them to the next two meetings. Also, please pass this list on to your family and friends and elicit their help in providing the much needed items for these kids.
