BPW 92nd Annual Conference My thoughts - Rosalind Silletto

Saturday, May 21 I attended the BPWNJ 92nd Annual Conference. It was a wonderful experience in so many ways and disappointing in one big way.

The organization recognized three Women of Achievement. Browsers and viewing Web Pages/Sites

You may need to install and use another web browser. Most people, using personal computers, use Microsoft's "Internet Explorer" - because it comes preinstalled on your personal computer and it is your first connection to the Internet (the icon is the "e" with the swoop around it. You may see this on your desktop as a shortcut or in your "programs" listed as Internet Explorer or on your taskbar. It is not the only browser that you are allowed to use, it is just what is offered.

Firefox is a serious competitor to Microsoft's Internet Explorer. It features a faster start up and shut down and it loads many web pages more quickly. You can download it here for free: <http://www.mozilla.com/en-US/firefox/new/>
