PC Tips by Lisa G., A2Z Computer Help

Phishing:

This is the act of sending an email to a user falsely claiming to

be an established legitimate business or company in an attempt to scam the user into giving up private information that will later be used for identity theft. Usually you are directed to a website where you are asked to update information, such as passwords, credit card and social security information,

etc. The website is fraudulent or bogus and is set up only to steal this information.

Some tips to stay secure is to simply avoid phishing scams and this starts with good email habits:

- -Do not respond to unsolicited email (or spam). Reputable businesses do not ask for passwords or personal information through email.
- -Do not click links in email messages.
- -Be aware of email attachments; they can install programs on your computer known as keyloggers. These programs record everything you type and if this happens, there is no need for a fake site to steal your information every key stroke you initiate will go direct to the crook. The program would need to be removed in order to stop the keylogging.
